

Position Title: Nordic Rocks Program Lead

The Vasa Ski Club (VSC) is actively seeking a dedicated individual to take on the role of coordinating our Nordic Rocks program for the upcoming winter season. This is a paid position within VSC, offering a compensation of \$2000.00. The primary responsibilities of this role include outreach to schools within the TCAPS system, which may also encompass some private institutions. Typically, this outreach is conducted through the TCAPS directory available online, with a specific focus on reaching out to the physical education teachers who will ultimately determine their interest in hosting a Nordic Rocks program at their school.

The chosen candidate will collaborate closely with VSC volunteers to ensure the seamless delivery of skis to the schools participating in the program. Furthermore, VSC maintains a database of schools and contacts from previous years, which can serve as a helpful template for initiating contact.

The core Nordic Rocks program implementation will be overseen by the respective gym teacher at each school, with any necessary support during gym class periods managed by these educators. The program coordinator, with support from VSC, will arrange meetings with the gym teachers to introduce them to the program and suggest tried-and-tested exercise routines that have yielded success in the past.

Upon the conclusion of the winter season, the program coordinator will be responsible for submitting data to VSC, detailing the number of participating schools and the number of children who had the opportunity to experience skiing through the program.
